Abstract

The study has been conducted on a sample of 50 girls' cadets of NCC. The NCC girls' cadets belong to different college of Firozabad District. The multidimensional personality – Extroversion – Introversion, high self-concept – low self-concept, Independence-Dependence, Balance-Imbalance Temperament, high adjustment-low adjustment, High Anxiety-Low anxiety has been investigated. Descriptive survey method has been used for the study. Researcher has been used multidimension personality Inventory by Manju Agrawal for collection the data. The finding showed that there is no significant difference on Urban and Rural Girls cadets of NCC.

INTRODUCTION

The NCC Cadet Corps, established in India in 1948, is a very important youth organization. Its aim is to develop a sense of discipline, leadership and patriotism among the citizens of the country. With more than 1.5 million cadets in schools and colleges across the country, NCC plays a very important role in shaping the future generations of India. The motto of the organization is "'Unity' and 'Discipline'". To establish national unity, NCC pledges to promote social tolerance and character building among the youth.

The NCC Cadet Corps was first established in India in 1917. After independence, NCC was formally placed under the National Cadet Corp Act in 1948. Since then, this organization has been playing a very remarkable role. In this, cadets participate in various activities, such as military training, community service, adventure activities and leadership development programs.

Objective of NCC -

1. The objective of NCC is to develop ideal qualities of patriotism, character building, brotherhood, discipline, leadership, secularism, interest in adventure and innovation, sportsmanship and selfless service among the youth of the country.
2. To inspire the youth and prepare them as an organized and trained human resource, so that they can always be ready to serve the country along with leading in every field.
3. To inspire the youth to make a career in the armed services and create a suitable environment.

The funds are shared by the Central and State Governments. The basic functional sub-unit in colleges and Plus Two institutions, having SW/SD Cadets is a Company. It is mandatory that the cadets of a particular company are from the same institution having the sub-unit. However, there is a provision for a system of giving Open Vacancy specifically to a NCC Sub-unit of

some institutions, as a special case, where students from other institutions which are not holding NCC can also join.

The purpose of this study was to evaluate the difference in multidimensional personality of Urban and rural NCC girl's cadet of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh

In which 25-25 NCC girl's cadets from urban and rural levels from different colleges of Firozabad district were selected for this study through random sampling method. A ready-made multidimensional personality tool was used to find out the multidimensional personality level of NCC cadets. The result will show that the multidimensional personality of urban NCC girl cadets and rural NCC girl.

Objective:

To study the Extroversion – Introversion dimension of the personality of rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh.

To study the High self-concept – Low self-concept dimension of the personality of rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh.

To study the Independence – Dependence dimension of the personality of rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh.

To study the Balance – Imbalance temperament dimension of the personality of rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh.

To study the High adjustment – Low adjustment dimension of the personality of rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh.

To study the High anxiety – Low anxiety dimension of the personality of rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh.

Hypothesis:

There is no significant difference between the multidimensional personality of the rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh.

The rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh does not differ significantly in their Extroversion-Introversion dimension.

The rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh does not differ significantly in their high self-concept – Low self-concept.

The rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh does not differ significantly in their Independence – Dependence.

The rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh does not differ significantly in their Balance – Imbalance temperament.

The rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh does not differ significantly in their high adjustment – Low adjustment.

The rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh does not differ significantly in their high anxiety – Low anxiety.

Sample

A sample of 50 students has been taken from the rural and urban NCC girl's cadets of Firozabad district of Uttar Pradesh.

Tools

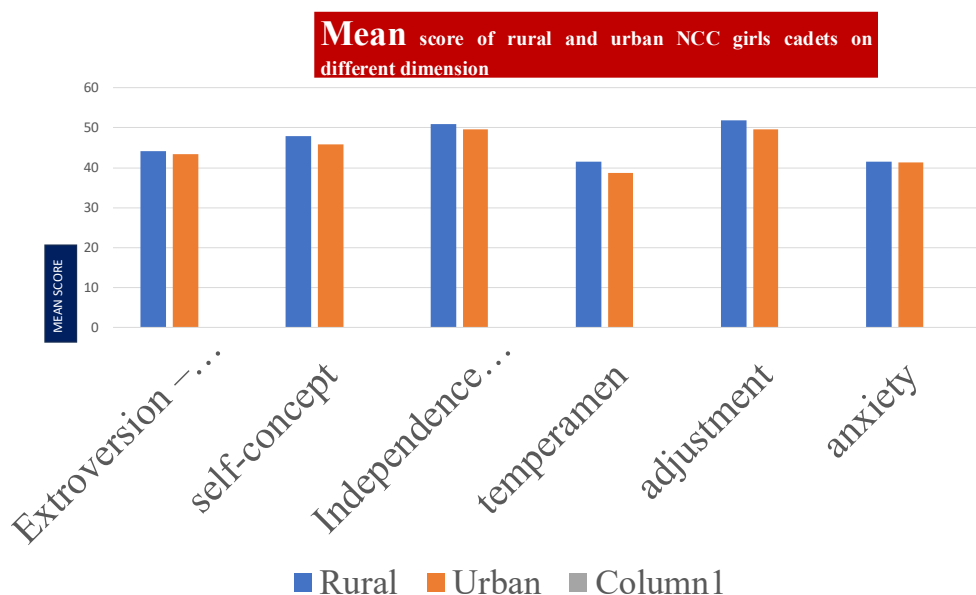

They do not differ significantly on this dimension. This means that most of rural and urban NCC girls cadet fall in ambivert category. The main score of high self-concept- low self-concept dimension of rural NCC is 47.88 and urban NCC girl's cadets 45.82. Table Number 2 also show that both the group are similar. They do not differ significantly on this dimension. rural and urban NCC girl's cadet has average self-concept. The mean score of Independence- dependance dimension of rural NCC girls' cadets is 50.94 and urban NCC girls' cadets is 49.6. both the group are very much similar. They do not differ significantly on this dimension. rural and urban NCC girl's cadet has average Independence. The mean score of balance-imbalance temperament dimension of rural NCC girl's cadet age 41.48 and urban NCC girl's cadet 38.7. Both the group are different. They do differ significantly on this dimension. Rural cadets have average temperament and urban cadets have poor temperament. Temperament has a major role in our personality. The mean score of high adjustment-law adjustment dimension of rural NCC girl's cadet is 51.9 and urban cadet is 49.64. both are group similar. They do not differ significantly on this dimension. Rural and urban NCC girls' cadets has average adjustment that Means the cadet have good adjustment. This personality dimension has a very major role in personality. The mean score of high anxiety-low anxiety dimension of rural NCC girl's cadet is 41.44 and urban cadet is 41.24. Bodh the group are moderate. They do not differ significant on this dimension.

Conclusions: -

In the end of study, we concluded that it has been founded that rural NCC girl's cadet and urban NCC girl's cadet has similar personality characteristics. it is observed that the both the group have similarly on different dimension of personality. Only little bit difference in temperament.
